| Reflection: Five finger Prayer Guide. | Rite for Christian Initiation for Adults | Please pray for: |

1. Your thumb is nearest to you. So begin your prayers by praying for those closest to you. They are the easiest to remember.

2. The next finger is the pointing finger. Pray for those who teach, instruct and heal. This includes teachers, doctors, nurses, counsellors, priests, sisters and others in the caring profession.

3. Next is the tallest finger. It reminds us of our leaders. Pray for our leaders in government, business and industry. These people shape our nation and guide public opinion. They need God's guidance.

4. The fourth finger is our ring finger. Surprising to many is the fact that this is our weakest finger, as any piano teacher will testify. It should remind us to pray for those who are weak, in trouble or in pain. They need our prayers night and day.

5. Lastly is our little finger, the smallest finger of all. Here we should place ourselves in relation to God and others. Your little finger should remind you to pray for yourself. You yourself know best your own needs and concerns.

Children attending non-Catholic schools: There will be baptism and first Sacrament of Confession and Holy Communion classes for children aged 8 and over, who are not in Catholic schools. Please pick up a form, and give it to any of the priests. Forms are to be completed and returned by 4th September. The first class will be on Saturday 29th October at 10.30 am in the parish centre.
