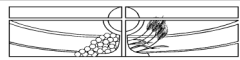

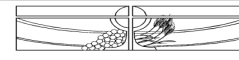
**Mission statement**

## Roof Leakage quote and breakdown

**Right side roof.**  
 Clean the roof completely & primer the paving stones to make it ready for felt.  
 Supply and fit 1x lane underlay.  
 Supply & fit 1x top lane felt.  
 Supply & fit led flashing around the walls.  
**This job including materials cost = £6850.**

**Roof Top:** Supply & fit a scaffolding to get across on top roof  
 Check all the roof & find out the problem to sort out the leak.  
 Seal all the felt joints to make it waterproof.  
 Supply & fit a new led flashing on the drainage from one roof to another to make it waterproof.  
 Supply & put silicone around the existing led flashing.  
 Supply & put bitumen around the upstand wall.  
**This job including material costs = £3900**

Check all the roof & find out the problem to sort out the leak.  
 Seal all the felt joints to make it water proof.  
 Check the window and seal it where necessary.  
 Supply & fit a new led flashing on the drainage to make it waterproof.  
 Supply & put silicon around the existing led flashing.  
 Supply & put bitumen around the upstand wall.  
**Job including material cost = £1150.**  
**Total cost = £11,900**
