## Holy Year on the Theme of Mercy, 2015 - 16

Pope Francis has recently declared an Extraordinary Jubilee Year for the Church, calling it a "Holy Year of Mercy" The year will begin on 8th December 2015, the 50th Anniversary of the end of the Second Vatican council, and conclude on the 20th November 2016, the feast of Christ the King.

Pope Francis told the faithful in St. Peter's Basilica: "Dear brothers and sisters, I have thought about how the Church can make clear its mission of being a witness of mercy. It is a journey that starts with a spiritual conversion. For this reason I have decided to declare an Extraordinary Jubilee that has the mercy of God at its centre. It will be a Holy Year of Mercy. I am convinced that the whole Church will be able to find in the jubilee the joy of rediscovering and making fruitful the mercy of God, with which we are all called to give consolation to every man and every woman of our time.
