Reflection: Your faith and prayer.	Prayer for our Parish.	The Holy Father's Universal Intention for this month : <i>That all Christians may be faithful to the Lord's teaching by striving with prayer and fraternal charity to restore ecclesial communion and by collaborating to meet the challenges facing humanity.</i>
<p>In personal prayer our faith talks and listens and mediates. In prayer the challenge is to be real, truthful, heartfelt, unaffected.</p> <p>In personal prayer we approach the God of all mercies without make-up or disguise, without mask or pretence, hoping to find an expression for who we are and what we're facing in life.</p> <p>Personal prayer is not performance; it is the language of real life.</p> <p>As in the great book of the Psalms, prayer can be a scream or a groan, a grievance for some slight; it might be an angry complaint; it could be a thank you note for a loved one or for a special grace; it could be delicious praise, shyly made.</p> <p>The psalms teach us that we should pray always, no matter what. Whatever mood or condition we are in, whatever is happening in our life, we always keep in touch with God.</p> <p>Prayer, of course, is not just about ourselves, transfixed by our own agenda. We are expected to have a place in our prayer and in our lives for those who are poor or lonely, for those who feel rejected or forgotten, for all who feel hurt by life and have no one to support them.</p> <p>Prayer is not only being open to God about ourselves but bothering God about the legion of the overlooked. Prayer pushes us out, beyond ourselves.</p>	<p>Almighty God our Father, in your wisdom and providence you created us in love and you call us to love in this faith community, Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Camberwell.</p> <p>We thank you for your manifold favours and blessings, which have accompanied and strengthened us in our efforts to meet the challenges of our Parish.</p> <p>As we continue with the onerous tasks of pursuing the necessary Spiritual, Pastoral and Infra-structural developments of our church, we beg you to sanctify our intentions and bless the feeble works of our hands.
