<p><i>Lent is many things. It is a period of retreat; a privileged moment of grace: a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving: an opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Mercy, grow in faith and renew our friendship with god.</i></p> <p><i>However, it is also a special and unique time for us to pray, mediate and contemplate on the cross of Christ, the cross of love.</i></p> <p><i>Jesus' life was a pilgrimage back to the Father's house - from the crib in Bethlehem, to the cross outside the city wall of Jerusalem.</i></p> <p><i>Lent is a pilgrimage back to the Father's house - from the sober call of repentance on Ash Wednesday to Jesus' Passion and Death, and the victory and joy of Easter Sunday. Our hearts sing the glory and praise of God as we look upon the depth of God's love revealed on the cross. How do we know what love is? St. John tells us: "This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ down his life for us."
