Rite for Christian Initiation for Adults

Calling on all adults who wish to be baptised, confirmed, or to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, to please pick up an initial inquiry form in the priest's sacristy.

This programme is for you, if:

- You are an adult, not yet baptised, single or married.
- You have been attending another church, and wish to know more about the Catholic Church.
- You wish to baptise your children so that they can attend Catholic schools, and you are not yet baptised or confirmed.

Please speak to any of the priests, or to Isaac, if you need more clarification. These forms should be returned by the end of August, and preparation classes will begin on Wednesday 13th September at 7pm in the parish hall.

Children attending non-Catholic schools: There will be baptism and first Sacrament of Confession and Holy Communion classes for children aged 8 and over, who are not in Catholic schools. Please pick up a form, and give it to any of the priests. Forms are to be completed and returned by 4th September. The first class will be on Saturday 29th October at 10.30 am in the parish centre.
