## Advent

What scripts and role models do advent and Christmas offer us for our practice sessions? Before Christmas, Advent proffers the long history of God's people waiting down millennia for the Saviour first promised in the Garden of Eden.

But it also hints that the wait will not be over by Christmas.

Although the promise has been kept with the birth of Christ, it will not be bought to completion until he returns in glory to close the play with the final entry of God's eternal reign.

Christmas offers encouragement and warning as we study the parts played by those who welcomed Christ - Mary and Joseph, Shepherds and Magi, Simeon and Anna, disciples and saints, the hungry, the lepers, the blind, the sick - and those who rejected Him - King Herod, those who stoned St. Stephen, even the unconverted Saul of Tarsus.
