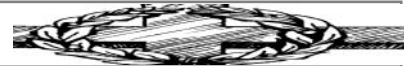
## Mission statement

**The Holy Year of Mercy**

On December 8th the Holy Door in St.Peter's Basilica is opened and the Year of Mercy, declared by Pope Francis, begins.

We begin our pilgrimage of mercy, a journey to the Father's heart, who is merciful, kind and full of compassion.

Forgiveness is an art as is being merciful - but an art informed by God's grace.

We can only forgive as we have been forgiven; we can only be merciful as we have received mercy.

The Holy Spirit is always at work in our lives - convincing and convicting of sin but also pouring out and filling us with God's mercy and love.

When this movement of God takes root in us we grasp more fully the meaning of the saying, ' But for God's grace go I. ' @For it is God's grace which protects us, leads us not into temptation and makes us reach out to others with love and mercy in our hearts.

May we all find mercy in the Lord and truly be merciful throughout this Holy Year.



**Clergy support fund.**

This is the first of two important messages about sick and retired priests and the Clergy support fund campaign which is being launched to support them.

A priest will normally retire from full time Parish Ministry when he reaches 75 years old age. Many continue to work in some ministry. When a priest resigns from his parish ministry or a full time ecclesiastical appointment the Diocesan Finance Office establishes his likely income and needs on an individual basis and ensures he has sufficient financial resources to afford the necessities of life, live in properly heated and adequately maintained accommodation and can pay for some recreation and travel.

There are currently 70 retired priests in our diocese and this number is expected to increase to about 93 by 2018. The costs of supporting them are currently met by the Diocese, partly through an annual contribution from each parish, but the increase in numbers will create more pressure on these costs. A summary of the costs, income and shortfall over the five years is available on request

Archbishop Peter Smith has therefore identified the need to continue to support sick and retired priests as a major priority for our diocese. Kindly pick up a form from the porches and return as soon as possible and place in the boxes provided. Thank you for your generosity.
