Parish Hall:

In recent past, the Sacred Heart School and the Parish have had some challenges with regard to the use and maintenance of the shared Parish hall and the Sixth form Centre. Members of the Pastoral team and representatives of the school have met to discuss issues and agree a way forward. As a result, a new hall caretaker committee was set up to supervise the use of the hall and liaise with the school on a regular basis. This has improved relations between the Parish and the school authority but some niggling issues/comments remain and these need to be fully resolved.

In the best interest of all, the Parish has engaged the services of a management company who will henceforth be responsible for the overall management of our Parish hall. This will include lettings, maintenance, cleaning, general upkeep and liaison with the school authority. This new arrangement will not affect the use of the Parish hall by community and pious groups for their meetings or prayers but only functions that involve food and drink.

In order to provide professional standard of cleaning that is required of a learning environment, hirers of the Parish hall will no longer be required to clean after functions but instead make a payment of £150.00 for cleaning services. This payment is due at the time of booking and takes effect from the 1st of September, 2015.
