Diocesan Day for Catechists: Saturday 23rd September, please speak to Isaac to confirm and complete your registration for the day.

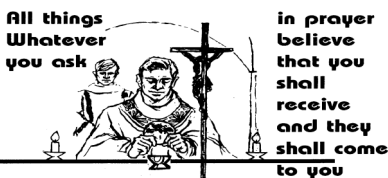
