**Reflection : The Most Holy Trinity**

*Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the feast of the Triune God manifested in three persons, The Father, Son and the Spirit.*

*In our practice of Christian Life, the Trinity is remembered often in prayer and during the daily routine by every Christian. Each time we make the sign of the cross, as we do at the beginning of every Mass, we say: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."*

*The feast of the Most Holy Trinity is a mystery and a mystery is precisely something that one does not fully understand. This does not mean that we are unable to express anything at all concerning this reality; on the contrary, we are able, thanks to what Jesus told us, to describe this mystery a little and to grasp it through comparisons and images. Our faith tells us that these three persons are indeed distinct and yet together. And that God is so closely associated with the human kind that he sent his Son and also he sent his own Spirit.*
