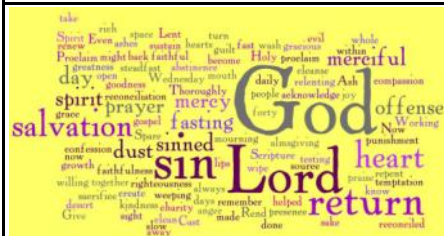
Sympathy

Pope Francis changes rules for washing of the feet

Pope Francis has decreed that from now on, the people chosen for the washing of the feet in the liturgy of Holy Thursday may be selected from all the people of God, and not only men and boys.

He has reflected on this for some time now, and with this change the "Rite of the washing of the feet contained in the Liturgy of the Mass in Coena Domini, with the intention of improving the way in which it is performed so that it might express more fully the meaning of Jesus' gesture in the Cenacle, His giving of Himself unto the end for the salvation of the world, His limitless charity."

"After careful consideration", he continued, "I have decided to make a change to the Roman Missal. I therefore decree that the section according to which those persons chosen for the Washing of the Feet must be men or boys, so that from now on the Pastors of the Church may chose the participants in the Rite from among all members of the People of God.

I also recommend that an adequate explanation of the rite itself be provided to those who are chosen".

Please pray for :

- for the Holy Father's Universal Intention for this month, 'that we may take good care creation - a gift freely given - cultivating and protecting it for future generations.'

- for Evangelisation: that opportunities may increase for dialogue and encounter between the Christian faith and the people of Asia.
