St. Monica.

All Christian mothers especially those with a difficult husband and wayward children, possess a powerful patron in St. Monica.

The Mother of St. Augustine was born in North Africa about the year 332 A.D and died happily 35 years later at Ostia, near Rome, as she was about to return home.

Her husband was Patricius, a minor Roman official, and a pagan with a hot temper, given to a loose life. Patricius inspired by Monica's patient endurance, died a holy death one year after his baptism.

The conversion of St. Augustine took much longer. St. Ambrose, Bishop of Milan, comforted Monica in her sorrow. "It is impossible," he said, "that the child of so many tears should be lost." St. Augustine dismissed his mistress, abandoned the Manichæan sect, and was baptized by St. Ambrose at Easter in 387 A.D. St. Monica died content soon after knowing her son to be at last a Christian.

Prayer for all Mothers. O Almighty and eternal God, Lord of both the living and the dead. Your tender mercy embraces all who are foreknown to be yours by faith and a good life. On this Mothers day, through the intercession of the Most Virgin Mary our Mother, grant your merciful pardon to all mothers for whom we pray, whether they still are living or have departed from this world. Bless most especially all the mothers of our parish community and grant them the choicest blessings they so desire. We make our prayer through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Parish Pilgrimage 2015.
Walking and praying in the footsteps of Jesus. Monday October 26th to Monday November 2nd 2015. Our parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land is taken off early to enable intending pilgrims make adequate preparation and save for this pilgrimage, which will cost about £1,190.00.

Pilgrimage details include return flights with BA from Heathrow to Tel Aviv; **7 nights accommodation on half board basis(breakfast and supper) 3 nights in Bethlehem, 2 nights in Tiberias, 2 nights in Jerusalem, with visits to all major sites in Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Jericho, Tiberias and Nazareth.** Additional fee applies to single rooms, and travel insurance, see the poster on the board for more details. This pilgrimage will accommodate 35 pilgrims on a first come first serve basis, only after an initial non-refundable deposit of **£300.00 to register**, after which you can spread your payment throughout the year, with the final payment expected by the end of July 2015 the latest.
 Registration can be made at the parish office or through any of the priests, verbal communication must be followed by a non-refundable deposit.
