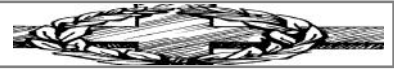

You are welcome for a blessing if you are not practicing or not Catholic with your arms crossed or if you come late to Mass.

**Confirmation 2016.**

Forms are now available in the Sacristy for those willing to prepare for Confirmation next year.

Confirmation is for practicing Catholics, who are already baptised, receive Holy Communion, and are in year 8 or other Adults who missed out at the early stage.

As part of the registration process, you will be required to get your parish priest to sign your application form confirming your parish membership.

Completed forms should be returned latest by the Sunday 20th December, 2015 with a copy of your **Baptism and First Holy Communion** certificates respectively. Note that the first date of class & compulsory meeting with Fr. Victor and parents, candidates, and all catechists will be on Friday 15th January, 2016 at 7.00pm

During this meeting formal introduction and registration will begin and candidates will be briefed on the procedures for this year's programme

Every Wednesday at 7.00pm in the church. This programme is for all adults who wish to be Baptised, Confirmed or received fully into the Catholic Church. Although the programme has started, we are still able to admit any one willing to join at this stage.

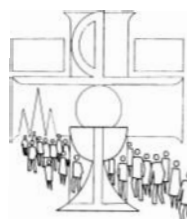
May we all find mercy in the Lord and truly be merciful throughout this Holy Year.
