Baptisms

To have the Baptism of a child under 5 parents should:

- obtain a light green form, and
- Attend the first preparation classes (for both parents)) at 2:30pm in Church. Baptism will then take place at the end of the month.

Older Children: If your Child is five and older, obtain a dark green form from the porch and return to any of the Priests or the Parish office.

Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion - if you child is at a non catholic school or is eight years or older and has not yet received these Sacraments please fill in a lilac form and return to the priest or the parish office.
