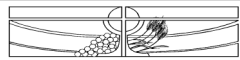

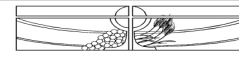
Mission statement

It is misnorer. When man's relevance is the measure of all things, truth is invariably sacrificed. God makes us to see a miracle in order to be glorified. He can give you a miracle without your efforts, but he also needs your faith, your repentance your presence and true worship of Him for a miracle to abound in your life. It is not a good Christian attitude, to duplicate attendance at religious programmes, of the same value and relevance. I plead with you to give your all to Christ and worship God in your parish community fully and dedicatedly, thereby allowing your faith to reach its full potential in the process benefitting immensely from the different parish activities that is always within your reach.
