Food for thought:

My Faith, My Family, My Future.

Faith is a special supernatural gift from God which enables us to believe without doubting whatever God has revealed. The things that God has revealed to us are seen not only in the created world around us but, also in the teaching of Scriptures and the interpretation of God's actions that the Church gives through the Holy Spirit. These includes the very existence of the human community of which the family is a basic cell.

The Church teaches that "The Creator of all made the married state the beginning and the foundation of human society" (Apostolicam Actuositatem, no.11). The married state is, by its very nature, established for the wellbeing of the spouses and upbringing of children (Can. 105). The role of the family, therefore, is to promote the wellbeing of individuals in the society. The society in turn has a natural duty to promote and sustain family life as a divine institution.

Something more crucial among them all is the neglect of the proper upbringing of children. Some governments in recent years have bombarded our homes with unhealthy legislations that are anti-family through the mass media. Certain models contrary to the sanctity of human life are being promoted; hence, there is the gradual enthronement of a culture of death. Methods contrary to nature and Christian principles are now being propounded for family life. Thus, a reawakening of family values is necessary to prevent terrible personal and social consequences.

Parish Pilgrimage 2015

Walking and praying in the footsteps of Jesus. Monday October 26th to Monday November 2nd 2015.

Our parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land is taken off early to enable intending pilgrims make adequate preparation and save for this pilgrimage, which will cost about £1,190.00.

Pilgrimage details include return flights with BA from Heathrow to Tel Aviv; **7 nights accommodation on half board basis (breakfast and supper) 3 nights in Bethlehem, 2 nights in Tiberias, 2 nights in Jerusalem, with visits to all major sites in Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Jericho, Tiberias and Nazareth.**

Additional fee applies to single rooms, and travel insurance, see the poster on the board for more details.

This pilgrimage will accommodate 35 pilgrims on a first come first serve basis, only after an initial non-refundable deposit of **£300.00 to register**, after which you can spread your payment throughout the year, with the final payment expected by the end of July 2015 the latest.

Registration can be made at the parish office or through any of the priests, verbal communication must be followed by the non-refundable deposit.
