All our children from year 8 and above who are attending non catholic schools or Catholic schools outside of Sacred Heart school, who have done their first holy communion, are also encouraged to pick up a form. Those at sacred Heart school will receive their forms from their school. The forms are to be filled properly and returned to the Parish office with a photocopy of your Baptismal and first holy communion certificates attached not later than 15th December.
