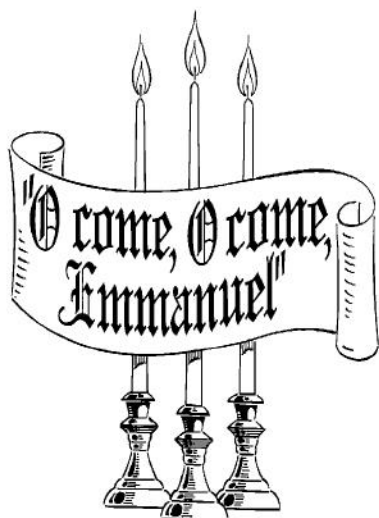

Confirmation 2015:

Forms are now available in the Sacristy for those willing to prepare for Confirmation next year.

Confirmation is for practicing Catholics, who are already baptised, receive Holy Communion, and are in year 8 or other Adults who missed out at the early stage. As part of the registration process, you will be required to get your parish priest to sign your application form confirming your parish membership. Completed forms should be returned latest by the first week of January 2015 with a copy of your **Baptism and First Holy Communion** certificates respectively. Note that the first date of class & compulsory meeting with Fr. Victor and parents, candidates, and all catechists will be on Friday 16th January at 7.00pm. During this meeting formal introduction and registration will begin and candidates will be briefed on the procedures for this year's programme.
