Sacraments:

Rite Of Christian imitation for Adults:

The RCIA programme for adults who wish to be baptised or confirmed in the Catholic faith or are lapsed in faith and wish to deepen their knowledge of the faith. This year's programme will begin in September.

At this time we are calling on all those who wish to enrol to please pick up an Initial Inquiry form in the Sacristy as we begin our selection process for this programme.

Forms should be duly completed and returned to the Parish Secretary or any of the Priests latest by the end of July.

Baptisms

To have the Baptism of a child under 5 parents should:

- obtain a light [green](#) form, and
- Attend the first preparation classes (for [both](#) parents)) at 2:30pm in Church. Baptism will then take place at the end of the month.

Older Children: If your Child is five and older, obtain a dark green form from the porch and return to any of the Priests or the Parish office.

Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion - if you child is at a non catholic school or is eight years or older and has not yet received these Sacraments please fill in a lilac form and return to the priest or the parish office. The programme for these Sacraments will start at the end of September.
