**First Friday devotion**

Friday 4th March is our monthly First Friday devotion, adoration will take place after the funeral Mass and continue after the stations of the Cross with all night adoration till dawn.  
 Could you spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord during this Year of Mercy.

**Development of the Stations of the Cross. Part 1.**

A prayer form that is most often associated with the Season of Lent, the Way of the Cross (as it is formally called) is a prayer for all seasons. The idea of this prayer came from the ancient practice of pilgrimage. Some who had particular spiritual burdens to discharge, penances to do, or needs to intercede for would make the long journey to the Holy Land on foot in search of the special graces attached to the land where Christ had walked.  
 Obviously, this took considerable time and resources to accomplish, and not everyone could make the journey even once in a life time. But the special benefits of a pilgrimage were enormous, not the least of which the community that often spontaneously formed along the way for protection, mutual encourage, and fellowship. The final leg of the journey was to follow the Via Dolorosa, or Way of the Sadness - the route that Jesus presumably took through Jerusalem to Calvary with his cross.  
 It was this final stage of pilgrimage that led to the idea of the stations, or stops, that Jesus took along that sad street.



**Parish Pilgrimage 2016.**

In this Year of Mercy our parish pilgrimage will take us to

**Rome, San Giovanni and Assisi from Oct 2 4th- 31st October, 2016.**

Due to the great number of pilgrims going to Rome for the Holy Year, and because our pilgrimage is during the half term, it is considered a peak period and we have been informed that this pilgrimage can only accommodate 35 pilgrims strictly on first come first serve basis for a total cost of £820.00.

Pilgrims are now encouraged to register with a non returnable deposit of £200.00 per person

Registration forms are available in the Parish office upon receipt of payment, which can also be paid directly to Tangney Tours.

Be advised that only 6 single rooms are available for this pilgrimage, other rooms are shared double.
