We pray for those we have known and for those we never knew. Our charity and our prayers embrace all those who have died lonely deaths in the absence of love and support. They are part of our ministry of prayer. We keep that tradition of charity alive during November when we pray for the dead.

We also rejoice in the saints we have known and know: their name is legion. We bless God for those who have out-smiled the jibes of oppressors, for those whose whispered prayers have enriched us all, for those who struggle honestly against ending up selfish. We express our gratitude for those who keep on forgiving with an energy worthy of God.

The kingdom is peopled by those who have gone before us and those among us who live Gospel lives. Goodness is not limited to any age of history; neither the past nor the present has a monopoly on saints. We belong to a community that has a history of goodness and we are part of that chain of faith and holiness.
